ISM Integration Toolkit

PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN INTERNATIONALS AND AMERICANS

Developing and strengthening partnership between internationals and Americans isn't something we can do in a one-time training, nor can trainings alone lead to strong partnership necessarily. We need to weave cross-cultural values and experiences into the fabric of our ministry. Each training, cross-cultural experience, and even subtle message on partnership builds on each other. Here are some ideas.

Do One or More Activity Below and Debrief Afterwards*

- Attend an international event on campus.
- Bring a few key students to visit a first-generation immigrant church, an ISM chapter, or an ethnic-specific chapter (if different from cultures of American students). Depending on the size of the chapter or church, more than 3-4 may be overwhelming or distracting for the hosts.
- Ask international students to pick a film that represents their culture or is from their country. Watch it together.
- (You get the idea... brainstorm more ideas!)

* Sample Debrief Questions:

- 1. What did you like about your experience?
- 2. What surprised you? What did you learn?
- 3. What questions do you have?
- 4. In what ways did you feel uncomfortable or dissonance? (If applicable).
- 5. Put yourself in their shoes. How do you think a person from this culture would feel if they were to visit your chapter?
- 6. How does leadership in this setting differ from your culture?
- 7. How changes might we make in our leadership community?

Trainings & Leadership Meeting Ideas

- Study passages on partnership and unity. Ex. Acts 6:1ff, Eph 2:11ff etc.
- Starting Int'l Small Groups 4 training sessions
- Crossing Cultures with Jesus chapters 3, 4, 5, 6, & 8, use discussion questions in book
- East vs West Cultural Values In each pair, share which value you identify more with. Discuss potential conflicts or miscommunication: What do you value more? Place yourself on the scale:

Other Ideas to Build Partnership

- Create space for relationships to deepen outside of ministry. Ex. Invite a small group of leaders (4-6) equal number of Americans and internationals over for dinner
- Facilitate one-on-one interactions between Americans and internationals. Ex. Pair them up as prayer partners or to lead a particular activity etc.
