Hear the word

Deuteronomy 10:17-19

For the Lord your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality and accepts no bribes. He defends the cause of the fatherless and the widow, and loves the foreigner residing among you, giving them food and clothing. And you are to love those who are foreigners, for you yourselves were foreigners in Egypt.

- Where are some places where you feel like a stranger? What is that like?
- Pray for those who are strangers here, and that we would welcome them well.

Respond actively

Cross-cultural training (optional)

Practice vision casting. Discuss a way you can meet new students (tabling? Welcome proxy?).

Roleplay meeting a new student. Commit to a personal goal of new students you will interact with (meeting, praying with, etc).

Debrief and Interpret

After meeting students:

- What was the experience like for you?
- How did you feel while doing it?
- What did God teach you about yourself while welcoming people?
- What did you learn about God?
