Hear the word

Matthew 28:16-20

But the eleven disciples proceeded to Galilee, to the mountain which Jesus had designated. When they saw Him, they worshiped Him; but some were doubtful. And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.

- What do you learn about the disciples?
- What do you learn about Jesus?
- What's the significance of his last words to his disciples?
- How is fulfilling this command (Go therefore and make disciples of all nations) possible?

Respond actively

- What might Jesus invite you to pass along from what you've learned recently?
- How can you model what you have learned?
- Who are the potential people that Jesus might want you to disciple (teach what Jesus has already taught you)? Pray for discernment, get input.

Invite those people to learn from you.

- "Hey Jesus has been teaching me _____ and I'd like to share about it with you. Can we meet up _____?"
- "Hey, Jesus put you on my heart and I'd like to talk more. Can we meet up?"

Debrief and Interpret

- How did it go for you? What went well? Where did you feel stuck?
- How did they respond?
- What did you learn about yourself?
- What did you learn about God?
- What is a next step for them and how can you model that?

Expand the influence

Invite them to continue meeting
