

## PRAYER MAP

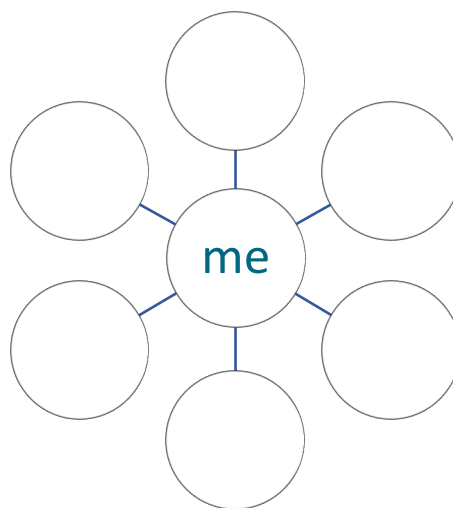
Who are the internationals you already know? Write their names in the circles. Don't know any yet? No worries! Check out the ideas in **orange** on how to meet them.

## GOING DEEPER

1. Pray regularly for your network. Put it in your calendar!

2. Ask questions to grow trust and curiosity. Try these questions with nonbelievers in your network and invite other believers to try them:

- What do you miss or appreciate most about home?
- What are some of your dreams and goals for your time in the U.S.?
- What are some values that are important to you?
- What's your spiritual background?
- What has surprised you the most about Christians?

3. Internationals often move quickly to the first two thresholds—trust and curiosity, but they tend to stay there. Try these questions once trust and curiosity have been established to help your friends move towards openness and beyond.

- Invite them to engage with Jesus in Scripture and ask: **How is learning from Jesus challenging your personal values and relationships?**
- **What are some barriers that might keep you from thinking about following Jesus?**
