Respond actively

(Staff): Look at what scripture will be studied at the next group Bible study. Have the student come up with some questions to ask about the passage that everyone can consider. Model inviting someone to a small group study.

Consider your networks of influence. Invite one person from one network to come to the next group Bible study.

Debrief and Interpret

- What was it like inviting someone? How did you feel?

- What was it like hearing people answer questions you thought of?
- Where did you see God at work?
