Hear the word

Luke 10:1-3

After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go. He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field. Go! I am sending you out like lambs among wolves."

As you can see, there are many non-Christians and only a few believers. It's a great opportunity to learn how to share your faith with those that are curious.

- What comes to mind when you think about this in terms of your home town?

Respond actively

Invite the student to be the Christian (laborer in the harvest field refer to Luke 10) in a breakout discussion in a large group/bible study. They don't have to lead the group, but can answer questions others have about Christianity.

Debrief and Interpret

- What was it like to be one of the only Christians in the group?
- What did you learn as you helped with the group?
- How did God meet you?
- How might this experience help you back home?
