3 Things to Know

- Multinational chapters intentionally include internationals in their vision and mission but are not exclusively for internationals.
- Multinational students/volunteers (internationals, immigrants, refugees, and third culture kids etc.) are on EVERY U.S. campus.



Multinational students/volunteers bring the gift of global perspective and often spiritual curiosity or spiritual leadership strengthened under persecution.



X Things to Avoid

Avoid siloing ISM. ISM small groups or subgroups can feel isolated if they're not integrated into chapter life.



- Avoid judging something you don't (yet) understand as different cultural practices and views can easily cause dissonance
- and disconnection.

 Avoid one-way relationships. Historically,
 Western hosts have leaned towards giving

3 Things to **Try**

Ask: how am I and my chapter being shaped by the nations and challenged by the global church?
