I-DIG QUICK START GUIDE

Welcome to the I-DIG! Here's how to get started on an exciting journey with God and each other.

- **Group facilitator(s),** read and follow the instructions on pp. 117-118 before the first meeting. **All group members,** read pp. 7-11 and pray about the commitments on p. 10 before the first meeting. P. 11 introduces the sections of the weekly studies.
- The first study begins on p. 24. During the first meeting follow the guidelines in the "Open" section there. Decide whether one person will facilitate all the discussions or people will take turns. If you volunteer to facilitate one of the meetings, read the general guidelines on pp. 117-118 and notes for your study on the following pages.
- If your group members come from a diverse mix of cultures **read the communication suggestions** in Tool A (p. 13).
- If you have people who are unfamiliar with Bible history, **read Tool B** (p. 15). Consider using the chart on p. 16 each week to help group members see where the "Dig In" Scriptures are in the context of the whole Bible.
- Feel free to **change your Bible study method** to accommodate different cultural learning styles. Tell the Scripture as a story, act it out, draw it or use colors and symbols to mark important points.
