How He healed me, to the uttermost.</p>	<p><i>Raised me:</i> in this context, brought me from death to life</p> <p><i>Holy Ghost:</i> God's Holy Spirit. (Hundreds of years ago, the word “ghost” had a different meaning, referring to a living spiritual being. The term “Holy Ghost” was used in an English translation of the Bible that was completed in 1611, but it is less common today, because God's Holy Spirit is nothing at all like the modern idea of a “ghost.”)</p> <p><i>Uttermost:</i> to the greatest amount</p>
<p>When I Think about the Lord, How He picked me up and turned me around, How He placed my feet on solid ground</p>	<p><i>Picked me up and turned me around:</i> gave me a new direction in life</p> <p><i>Placed my feet on solid ground:</i> put me on a good path where I would not fall</p>
<p>It makes me wanna shout, Hallelujah, Thank you JESUS, LORD, you're worthy, of all the glory, and all the honor, And all the praise...</p>	<p><i>Hallelujah:</i> praise God</p> <p><i>Worthy:</i> deserving of honor, having great worth</p> <p><i>Glory:</i> very bright; high honor and fame</p>
