Pitch 30 second vision (Community that loves and serves other and grows in love for God)
What do you like about this?

Respond actively

Would you join us and invite two friends to come and see with you?

Debrief and Interpret

Later that day: text/email, sharing excitement about meeting them and asking how inviting is going.

When they come to an event: Celebrate that they are there! Ask: How did your friends respond to the invitation?

Expand the influence

What responsibilities can you give them? Keep coaching in inviting.
